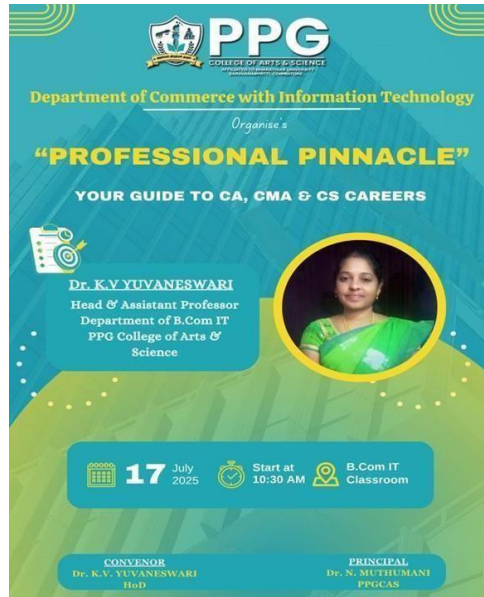
**Emerging Opportunities in Startups**

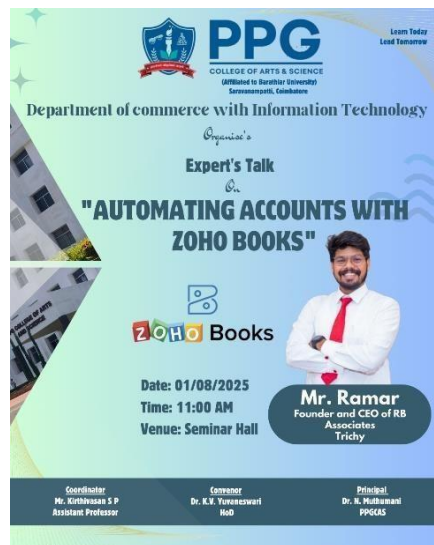
## “Professional Pinnacle”
